Annual awards celebrate the industry's finest

Aerosol Packaging

Winner: Lindal Group – Enhanced Mist Technology (EMT)

A two-part nozzle solution for low viscous water-based products, such as water and skin care fluids. Designed to produce a soft, quiet and gentle mist, whilst also incorporating a streamlined assembly process for fillers.



Runner up: Ball Corporation – Eyeris, it's all in the detail

A printing technique which enables brands to print photo-realistic details and textures like fur, human skin, fruit, vegetables and more on aerosol cans in the round (offset printing).
